



This statement of need form does not require listing specific employees or their positions. The form must be signed by the superintendent of the employing school district. It does not need to be co-signed by the county superintendent of schools.

A copy of the form does not need to be submitted to the county or the Commission with each Emergency 30-Day Substitute Teaching Permit application; however, the county superintendent of schools, whose responsibilities include areas such as district payroll or district substitute placement, may request a copy of the district's statement of need form to accurately fulfill these duties.

County superintendent of schools offices employing holders of the Emergency 30-Day Substitute Teaching Permit are also required to annually file, at their office, this completed statement of need form. The county superintendent of schools will sign the form.

The Commission does not require that the school board approve the statement of need. The individual school district may establish its own policy regarding this matter.

BILINGUAL PARAEDUCATOR

DEFINITION:

Under supervision and direction, tutors migrant and EL children. Meet with EL families to explain individual learning plans. Coordinate student programs with regular classroom teacher. Monitor student progress toward reclassification.

EXAMPLES OF DUTIES:

- Tutors individuals or small groups of students using methods, materials, and programs prepared for EL children.
- Visits homes for educational or health purposes.
- Assists parents to participate in school related activities.
- Prepares and submits required reports.
- Translates forms for the school or parents as requested.
