All other work, substrate repair, dryrot damage, unknowns, unforeseen issues, any painting except the benches & (N) Facia Boards, etc., is excluded.

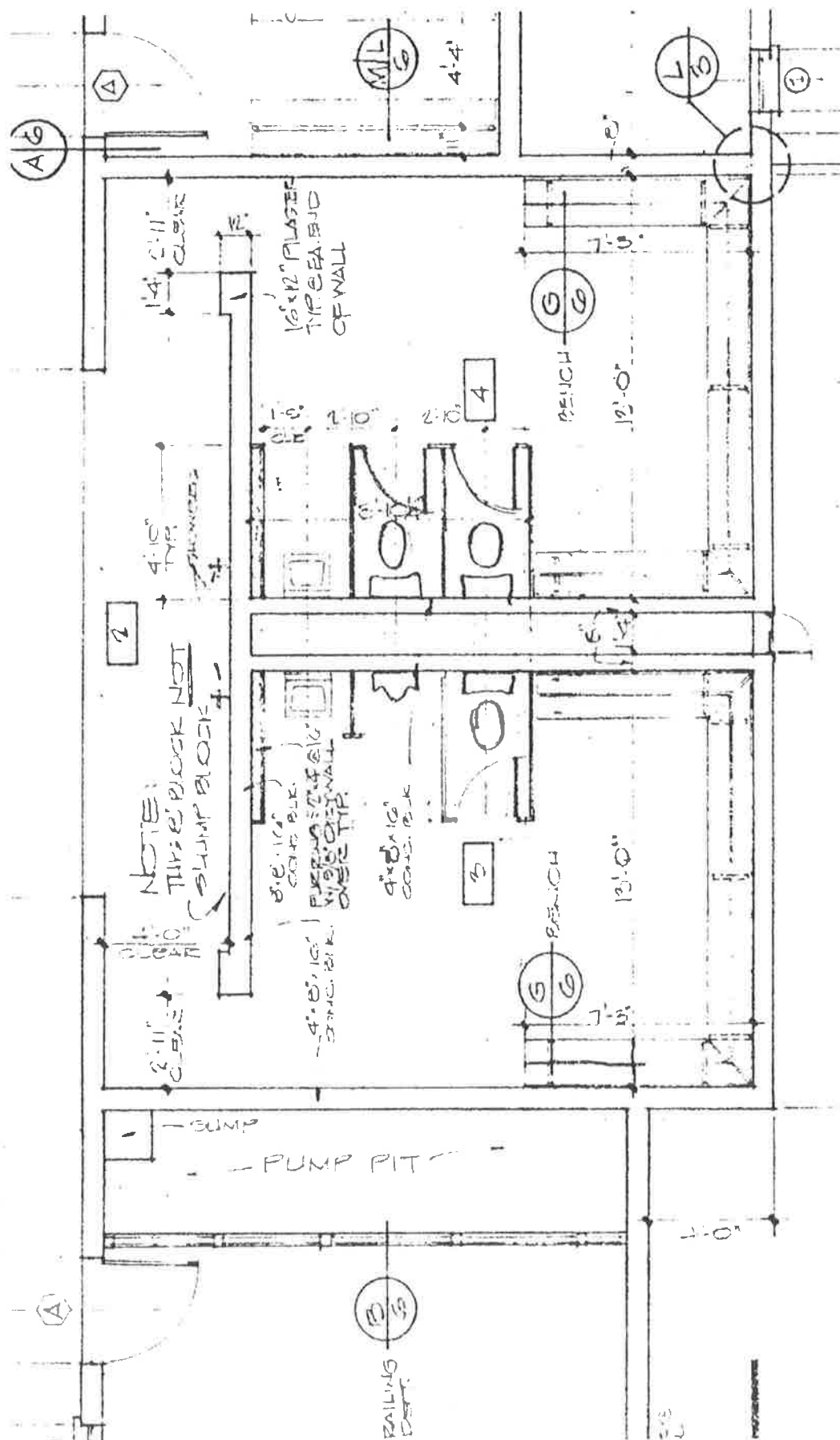
Septic System is presumed to be in working order & not part of this proposal.
