MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

Butte County Office of Education Coordinated District Support and Golden Feather Elementary School District

This Memorandum of Understanding ("MOU") is entered into between Golden Feather Elementary School District ("District") and Butte County Office of Education ("BCOE") as of July 1, 2020.

- 1. **Services**. The BCOE shall furnish to the Client the services as described in EXHIBIT "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by this reference ("Services").
- 2. **Term**. BCOE shall commence providing Services under this Agreement upon execution of the Agreement by both parties, and will diligently perform such Services as required. This MOU will be in effect for the 2020-2021 school year
 - 2.1. "Consultations" = Mutually agreed upon dates and times
 - 2.2. Fifty-two mutually agreed upon consultations,
 - 2.3. Consultations will not exceed 52 without mutual agreement by both parties.
- 3. **Compensation**. BCOE's compensation from the Client shall be based on one consultant's daily rate (salary and benefits) plus $\frac{1}{2}$ day of prep for each consultation. (\$650 x 1.5 = \$975 per day)
 - 3.1. Consultations that include more than one team member will <u>not</u> incur increased cost.
 - 3.2. Client agrees to pay <u>up to</u> \$50,700 for services rendered and materials (if applicable) during 2020-2021 school year.
 - 3.3. BCOE will initiate an S-Transfer for the amount due by June 15, 2021.
- **4. Independent Contractor**. BCOE, in the performance of this Agreement, shall be and act as an independent contractor.
- 5. Materials. Client shall furnish, and pay for all labor, materials, equipment, supplies and other items necessary for BCOE to complete the Services to be provided pursuant to this Agreement.
- 6. **Termination**. Either party may, at any time, with or without reason, terminate this Agreement with thirty (30) days written notice. BCOE will be compensated by Client for Services rendered up to the date of termination (i.e., BCOE will be compensated by Client for Services completed to date as a pro-rata amount of the full fees, costs, and expenses).
- 7. Indemnification. To the furthest extent permitted by California law, Client shall, at its sole expense, defend, indemnify, and hold harmless the BCOE, the State of California, and their agents, representatives, officers, employees, trustees, and volunteers (the "indemnified parties") from any and all demands, losses, liabilities, claims, suits, and actions (the "claims") of any kind, nature, and description, including, but not limited to, personal injury, death, property damage, and consultants and/or attorney's fees and costs,

directly or indirectly arising out of, connected with, or resulting from the performance of the Agreement or from any activity, work, or thing done, permitted, or suffered by the Client under or in conjunction with this Agreement, unless the claims are caused wholly by the sole negligence or willful misconduct of the indemnified parties. The BCOE shall have the right to accept or reject any legal representation that Client proposes to defend the indemnified parties.

- **8. Insurance**. The BCOE shall procure and maintain at all times it performs any portion of the Services its applicable forms of insurance.
- 9. **Notice**. Any notice required or permitted to be given under this Agreement shall be deemed to have been given, served, and received if given in writing and either personally delivered or deposited in the United States mail, registered or certified mail, postage prepaid, return receipt required, or sent by overnight delivery service, or facsimile transmission, addressed as follows:

Any notice personally given or sent by facsimile transmission shall be effective upon receipt. Any notice sent by overnight delivery service shall be effective the business day next following delivery thereof to the overnight delivery service. Any notice given by mail shall be effective three (3) days after deposit in the United States mail.

- 10. Attorney Fees/Costs. Should litigation be necessary to enforce any terms or provisions of this Agreement, then each party shall bear its own litigation and collection expenses, witness fees, court costs and attorneys' fees.
- 11. No Rights in Third Parties. This Agreement does not create any rights in, or inure to the benefit of, any third party except as expressly provided herein.
- 12. Integration/Entire Agreement of Parties. This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the Parties and supersedes all prior discussions, negotiations, and agreements, whether oral or written. This Agreement may be amended or modified only by a written instrument executed by both Parties. This Agreement is not valid until approved/ratified by the BCOE's governing board. Services shall not be rendered until Agreement is approved or ratified.
- 13. California Law. This Agreement shall be governed by and the rights, duties and obligations of the Parties shall be determined and enforced in accordance with the laws of the State of California. The Parties further agree that any action or proceeding brought to enforce the terms and conditions of this Agreement shall be maintained in Butte County, California.
- 14. Waiver. The waiver by either party of any breach of any term, covenant, or condition herein contained shall not be deemed to be a waiver of such term, covenant, condition, or any subsequent breach of the same or any other term, covenant, or condition herein contained.
- **15. Severability.** If any term, condition or provision of this Agreement is held by a court of competent jurisdiction to be invalid, void or unenforceable, the remaining provisions will nevertheless continue in full force and effect, and shall not be affected, impaired or invalidated in any way.
- **16.** Incorporation of Recitals and Exhibits. The Recitals and each exhibit attached hereto are hereby incorporated herein by reference.

Scope of Services for
